

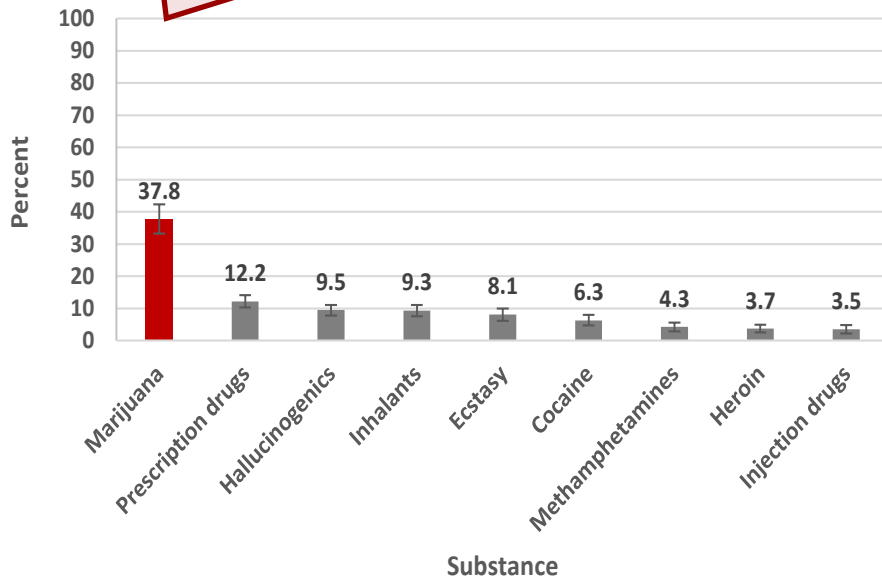
Youth Substance Use: Maui County

2017 Hawai'i State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup



More youth have used **marijuana** during their lifetime than *any other substance* (2015 YRBS).

13.5%
of Maui County youth
have used marijuana
before age 13



Compared to only
7.5% in the US!
(2015 YRBS)

How do we change this?

1. *Enhance* protective factors & reduce risk factors.
2. *Tailor* the program to the specific population, considering age, gender, and ethnicity.
3. Family-based prevention programs should enhance *family bonding* and include parenting skills.

Related *Risk* Factors:

Exposure to substance use and **community norms** can **increase** use in our youth!
